Dear Parents/Carers

Communication between home and school is an important part of supporting students in their learning journey and keeping up to date with school news and events. There are a range of ways that our school communicates with our school community, including the school Newsletter, Casula PS Facebook, Seesaw, email, Schoolstream and School Bytes.

The school has recently begun using Seesaw as our main communication platform, therefore, our use of the Schoolstream app will soon come to an end.

From Term 2, we will no longer use Schoolstream to communicate announcements and notes with you, so if you haven't already, please get connected to Seesaw as soon as possible!

How do I connect to my child's Seesaw journal?

Parents/Carers and students need to sign the Casula Public School's Seesaw Policy Agreement on SchoolBytes prior to using the communication platform. Once you and your child have signed the policy, your child's classroom teacher will have given you a copy of your Seesaw QR code at your Family Partnership Meeting or it will have been sent home if you booked a phone interview. The QR code note will explain how to set up Seesaw on your device. Each child will have their own unique QR code that once you scan via the app you will immediately be able to see your child's learning journal and will see any class and school announcements/notes.

Please see your child's classroom teacher or the front office as soon as possible if you need a copy of this QR Code.
